My pornography addiction separates me from God's love

TRUTH Your sin will never separate you from God's unconditional love and acceptance.

And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.

JOHN 8:31-32

LIE #6 I'm strong enough to control my pornography addiction on my own

TRUTH In order to find true freedom, you must give up on your own ability to control your sin.

Jesus can set others free from pornography addiction, but not me

TRUTH If you believe Jesus is Lord, you can trust that everything He promises is true, even for you.

Holding on to unforgiveness has no effect on my pornography addiction

TRUTH Unforgiveness is one of the most common ways of allowing spiritual bondage back into your life.

I must shut down my desires if I want to be free from pornography

TRUTH God doesn't want you to shut down your desires. He wants to redeem them for His good.

God can no longer use me because of my pornography addiction

TRUTH God loves to use broken people to do amazing things for His kingdom, regardless of their past.
